On August 25, 2009 at the Central Office (134 Marion Avenue N., Bremerton WA) from 4:00-6:00 PM, the Bremerton School District held an SES Provider Fair and all SES providers and eligible families were invited to attend. The school district has provided two windows of opportunity to sign up and will list the number of students that have participated in school choice/SES services.

The request for services must be made by November 2, 2009.

Note: 1,216 secondary students were eligible for Supplemental Educational Services outside the school day and 17 students participated.

The maximum per-pupil allocation for SES is 1,292.00 per student (secondary only).
