The proposed Replacement EP&O Levy renews a previously-approved levy that expires in 2024. In Bremerton, levy dollars support:

**100%** of extracurricular activities, like athletics, theater and music

89% of safety & security officers

83% of technology staff

82% of maintenance & custodial staff

73% of classroom support staff

32% of health services & counselors

22% of special education supports

21% of classroom teachers

## 2 PROPOSED BOND



A \$150 million bond of up to 25 years would pay for new construction and building renovations to improve schools and facilities constructed 37–78 years ago that have 21st century learning needs.
