

Candidate Orientation

Candidates for appointment or election to the Board shall be urged to attend public meetings of the Board. All public information about the school system shall be made available to them.

The Superintendent will cooperate impartially with all candidates in providing them with information about school governance, Board operations and school programs. Information to Board candidates may include the following:

- A. Notify the candidate of open meetings of the Board, accompanied with an agenda;
- B. Provide each candidate with access to publications from the Washington State School Directors' Association, the official minutes of Board meetings, and the District policy manual;
- C. Offer to meet with the candidate to provide background information on the school system and Board service and/or arranging such other candidate orientation sessions as the candidate may reasonably request;
- D. Provide each candidate with information regarding the Public Disclosure Act.
