

Child Custody

The Board, unless informed otherwise, assumes that there are no restrictions regarding the nonresidential parent's right to be kept informed of the student's school progress and activities. If restrictions are made relative to the above rights, the custodial parent will be requested to submit a certified copy of the court order which curtails these specific right(s).

Unless there are specific court-imposed restrictions, the nonresidential parent, upon request will be given access to all of the student's educational records, including, but not limited to, the student's cumulative file, records kept by the teacher and the student's special education file (when applicable), and, upon written request, an opportunity to conference with the student's teacher.

The student is not permitted to visit with or be released to anyone, including the nonresidential parent, without the approval of the custodial parent, except as laid out in policy or required by law.
