_____ I will achieve a minimum 3.25 cumulative grade point average.

_____ I will pass all sections of the WA High School Proficiency Exam in the 10th grade as well as End of Course Exams

_____ I will successfully complete Senior Portfolio Presentation with a score of 36 or above (outstanding).

_____ I will obtain annual Letters of Recommendation (or Personal Qualities Form) from a faculty or community member.

_____ I will participate in extra-curricular activities such as clubs and/or sports. I must be active for a minimum of four full semesters and/or seasons.

_____ I will complete a minimum of ten community service hours per year through a local or school-affiliated organization.

_____ At any time, I may request a meeting with the Knight Scholar Program Director to discuss the above expectations or request an exception due to extenuating circumstances.
