

What type of insurance do we accept?

PCHS accepts ALL medical insurance. For those without insurance or insufficient insurance coverage, we offer a sliding scale. * *We are not a contracted provider for Kaiser Permanente*

PCHS services are available to our patients without regard for ability to pay. This does not mean that services are free, but rather that a payment plan can be created, or other resources may be available

What is our policy for insurance in SBHC?

Services will be billed to the patient's insurance carrier. Patients who are uninsured may seek assistance from our certified Navigators available to help with enrollment. Sliding scale is offered to all patients.

What type of visits do insurance typically cover?

Evaluation and treatment of common health problems. Sports physicals, Mental, social and emotional health care, Preventive health care. Referrals to other health care providers as needed, Solution Focused, Training, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Student in Crisis and Chemical Dependency Coordination Service.

What if I am Active Duty/Spouse is Active Duty?

PCHS cannot see active duty military members but is able to provide all services to family members.
